11:00 am – 12:30 pm	<b>FLASH TALKS: Building Relationships In and Beyond the Classroom</b> How can educators build relationships that foster creativity and innovation between students, teachers, and community organizations? In this series of flash talks, educators will present and discuss recent collaborative projects involving a wide range of settings and participants. Presenters include Stephanie Joyce, 3 <sup>rd</sup> grade teacher from Crocker Farm Elementary School in Amherst, MA; Donna Moore, Art Specialist at Meadow Brook Elementary School in East Longmeadow, MA and Casie Smith, Director of the Early Learning Center at Hampshire College in Amherst, MA. The presentation ends with time for educators to ask questions, reflect, and share as a group.

2:00 – 3:30 pm	<b>Breakout Session #1:</b> Participants will select 2 of the following programs, facilitated by Carle Education Staff  <b>Visual Thinking Strategies in the Galleries</b> Visual Thinking Strategies (VTS) is a method of teaching viewers to find meaning and pleasure in works of art and is a foundation of the educational programming at The Carle. In this workshop, participants will focus on applying the principles of VTS to facilitate group discussion and foster critical thinking.  <b>Framing for Collaboration: Materials and Installations in the Art Studio</b> In this hands-on workshop, Carle Educators Meg Nicoll and Sara Ottomano will guide an exploration of how studio projects are designed for collaboration. Looking at the role of material limitations, examples, and prompts, we will discuss how intergenerational conversations can be started and sustained in the Art Studio.  <b>Collaborative Documentation in the Café</b> A cornerstone of the Reggio Emilia educational experience, documentation is a method of recording events as a tool for inquiry and reflection. In this hands-on workshop we will experiment with collaborative documentation, exploring how this process can enable us to collectively discuss, interpret, and build on children's interests and ongoing projects.
